STARS

This week we have been looking at people who help keep us healthy. We have talked about opticians, dentists, vets, doctors and nurses. We have also talked about healthy eating and exercise.

The children have enjoyed making a toothbrush, painting eyes the correct colour, putting a skeleton together and doing the skeleton dance!

SATURN

This week we have continued with a second week on dinosaurs. This week our focus story has been Harry and a Bucketful of Dinosaurs. We have done some fantastic writing about the story and have ended the week by writing about our favourite dinosaur. In maths our second week on subtraction has seen us all able to do simple subtraction sums and some of us can use number lines to calculate the answer. We made some dinosaur world pictures as well as did some dinosaur yoga during the week too.

JUPITER

This week we have been reading and discussing another traditional story, Snow White. We were especially amazed about the modern version of the story, Snow White in New York. In Maths we've been working really hard in comparing and ordering numbers through different representations. In History we have been taken on a journey alongside Florence Nightingale, who travelled to Turkey to help the wounded soldiers during the Crimean War.

Please remember the theme for Jupiter Class Art Competition Entries is Spring.

MARS

This week the children in Mars class have been watching our seeds germinate and become seedlings with green leaves. We are currently conducting an experiment in the classroom to prove what plants need to thrive. In maths the children used all the packaging brought in to look at weight and volume. They then practiced their column addition adding two packets weight or volume together. Some went into the thousands! Please don't forget the art competition being run by year 3, raising money for the outside learning area.

VENUS

This week in Venus Class, the children have been identifying the properties of 2D and 3D shapes in mathematics and completed the geometry unit. They have been using alliteration, repetition and onomatopoeia when reading and writing poetry in English. The children have also enjoyed making sundials and recording shadows throughout the day in science. We had the perfect weather for this experiment this week.

MERCURY

We have started our Geometry work in Maths this week and have been learning about turns and angles. In English we have finished reading The Wolves in the Walls and have been identifying character traits and predicting a sequel story. We started putting paper mache on our Olympic masks in DT and in Computing we have continued using search engines to answer different types of question.
