STARS

This week in Stars Class we have been talking about harvest. The children started the week with the story Oliver's Vegetables, and then went onto dig up and explore lots of different vegetables. The children have really enjoyed doing lots of vegetable based activities, including sorting, printing and making parsnip and carrot soup. We have also been lucky to have some new toys this week in Stars and have enjoying playing in our new class shop, farm and dolls house.


SATURN CLASS

Saturn Class have been talking about harvest and Thanksgiving this week. We have had the story of how the pil-grims travelled to America. In response we have all tried to make boats from different materials and then experimented to see if they would float. In phonics we have started Phase 3 of Letters and Sounds, focusing on 'j' 'w' and 'v' this week. In maths we have been learning about money and have practising paying with £1 and £2 coins.



JUPITER CLASS

This week we have been working with 2D and 3D shapes. We can name common 2D and 3D shapes, starting to learn how to spell their names and talk about their properties. We have also used 3D shapes to print 2D shapes! In English we have been reading the poem 'love it or hate it' and we have written our own version of the poem. In Art we have started to look at the artist Piet Mondrian, we recreated some of his artwork using felt tips and paint.



MARS CLASS

This week Mars class have been developing their money skills and using their knowledge of column method to help them add amounts together and use subtraction to find change. The children have been looking at the work by the artist Van Gogh, and chose to copy their favourite painting by that artist. In English we are looking at suffixes, added to root words to change tense and verbs to nouns.



VENUS CLASS

Venus class have been writing about settings and characters in English this week. They have been learning their 3 and 4 times tables in mathematics. They have been learning more about volcanoes in Geography too.

MERCURY CLASS

We have been reading the legend of Beowulf in English this week, and writing some great descriptions of the main characters. In maths, we have continued calculating 4-digit additions and subtractions, estimating answers, checking with the inverse calculation and applying to word problems. We enjoyed making models of Viking longships in Art.


